

SVN For Dummies

Linux

svn checkout

go to directory you want a copy of the files on the SVN to be stored

```
svn checkout svn+ssh:// <server name/path>
```

To use the following commands go to directory that contains the copy of the files on the svn

svn update

```
svn update
```

svn add

```
svn add <filepath/name>
```

svn delete

```
svn delete <filepath/name>
```

svn copy

```
svn copy <original filepath/name> <new filepath/name>
```

svn move

```
svn move <original filepath/name> <new filepath/name>
```

svn commit – uploads your version of the file specified to the svn repository

```
svn commit -m <"message"> <filepath/name>
```

Note: when using these commands do not include the < > symbols
